The design of superior quality yachts by Morgan Giles has been established over 45 years. For example, the fastest 6-metre yacht of 1912, the *Jonquil*,

swept the board. Her remarkable racing record that season out of 57 starts consisted of 44 firsts, 8 seconds and 3 thirds. In 1930 Morgan Giles was specially commissioned to design and build an 8-metre yacht, Hispania VI, for His Majesty King Alfonso of Spain. Between 1947–1960, considerable prestige developed from the creation of the West Channel Class Cruiser/Racers ($2\frac{1}{2}-17$ tons). Famous as sea-going cruising yachts, they were holders of many flags and cups for local and passage races. More recently, six Seamanship Training yachts were designed and built for the Britannia Royal Naval College, apart from many other craft.
